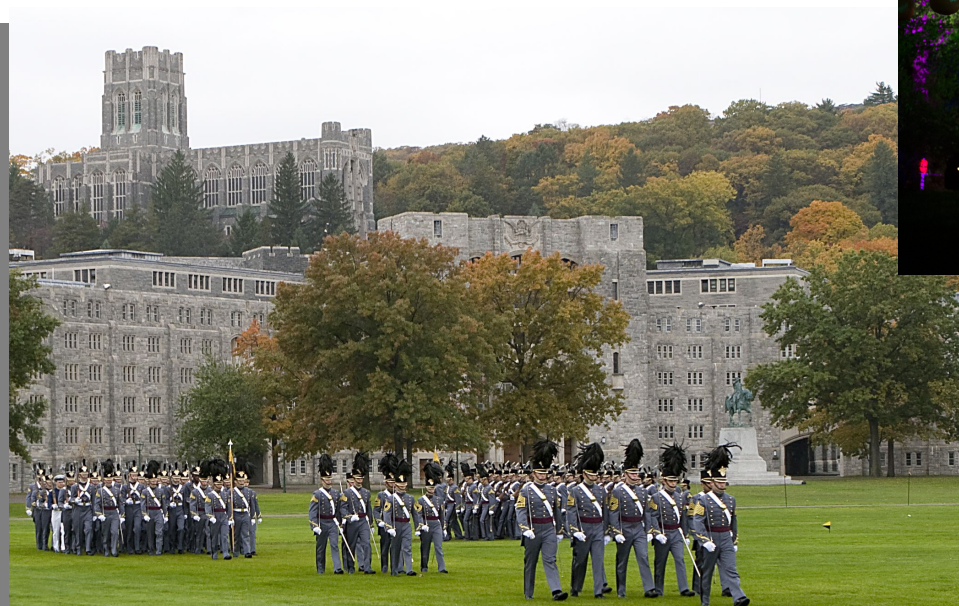

Proof of Citizenship:

West Point is an active-duty military post. **All guests 18 years of age and older must present a valid form of ID at time of booking their reservation for their travel agent to copy.** West Point will use this ID to run a background check prior to arrival. A driver's license, passport, military ID are acceptable forms. The same piece of identification must be presented the same day of the tour, no photocopies accepted at that time.

Smoking and Seating Information

No smoking is permitted on the coach. Seats are assigned according to the reception of the reservation. Seats will not be rotated. If you are traveling with another party, require a wheelchair lift, or need to request special seating due a disability, please inform us at the time the reservation is made.

Day 1 – Tuesday, October 19

Return to the hotel to relax before an early dinner at a local restaurant. This evening, experience **The Great Jack O'Lantern Blaze** at **Van Cortlandt Manor**, featuring thousands of **hand-carved, illuminated pumpkins**. Meals included: B, D

Day 3 – Thursday, October 21

Enjoy breakfast this morning before checking out of the hotel and continuing your **Hudson Valley** tour. Begin with a visit to **Lyndhurst Mansion** in **Tarrytown**, one of the Hudson Valley's great **Gothic Revival Estates**.
