Day 1 – Tuesday, March 30

Experience Washington, DC, at its most beautiful during the magical Bloom Time season*! Depart from your hometown and travel to Northern Virginia wine country, with comfort stops along the way. Visit 2 wineries for tastings. Lunch will be included at the first while you relax on the grounds and take in their many cherry blossom trees! After both stops, continue to dinner, included at Magnolias at the Miller, then to your hotel for check-in.

Day 2 – Wednesday, March 31

After breakfast at the hotel this morning, meet your DC Guide and board the coach for a day of sightseeing in and around Washington, DC! Start with a **Pink Stroll** and photo opportunity among the Japanese cherry trees along the **Tidal Basin**. These trees were a 1912 gift to the city of Washington from Mayor Yukio Ozaki of Tokyo to enhance the growing friendship between the US and Japan. The stroll will feature stops at the **Franklin D. Roosevelt Memorial, Martin Luther King, Jr National Monument and the Jefferson Memorial**. Board the motor coach again and continue to stops at the **Vietnam Veterans Memorial, Lincoln Memorial and Korean War Veterans Memorial**. Then, visit the **Hillwood Estate, Museum and Gardens** for an included lunch followed by a house and garden tour. The mansion is the former home of cereal heiress Marjorie Merriweather Post. This evening, you'll drive by the **Washington National Cathedral** and **Embassy Row** before continuing to dinner. Cap off the evening with an **Illuminated Monument Driving Tour** featuring Washington's grand buildings, memorials and monuments. The group will stop at the **National WWII Memorial** and the **Marine Corps Memorial** before returning to the hotel for the evening.

Day 3 – Thursday, April 1

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel this morning before boarding the bus along with your DC Guide. Today, you'll visit the **United States Capitol** for a guided tour of one of the most recognized symbols of democratic government in the world. Lunch will be on your own at the Capitol Visitor Center cafeteria. Continue after to the **United States Library of Congress**, the largest national library in the world with more than 100 million items in 3 buildings. Following your time at the Library, you'll board the coach and visit your choice of the **Smithsonian Institution's Museums on the National Mall***. After your museum visit, continue to an included dinner before returning to the hotel for the evening.

Day 4 – Friday, April 2

Following breakfast and check-out at the hotel, join your DC Guide for one last Washington experience! Visit **Arlington National Cemetery**, America's shrine to valor and sacrifice. Tickets are included in the visit for the tram tour – it typically makes several stops at significant locations including the **Tomb of the Unknown Soldier** and the **JFK Eternal Flame**. After touring, your guide will drop and the group will travel home with stops enroute.
