Day 1 – Friday, September 10

During your 2½ hour cruise you will experience magnificently preserved shipwrecks, scenic shorelines and majestic lighthouses. Learn about the history, legends and lore of Thunder Bay and many famous shipwrecks as you cruise the shoreline. After, visit next door at the **Great Lakes Heritage Center** for more information and boxed lunch. Continue to **Mackinac Island** with photo stops at **Old & New Presque Isle Lighthouses** enroute. This evening, enjoy dinner on your own after checking into your hotel.
